

Adopt-A-Highway Program

A great way to promote conservation...



<u>Our Chapter</u> is responsible for a two mile stretch of roadway on Orange Plank Road to support the Virginia effort to keep our highways free of trash. This little piece of highway is <u>our</u> part of the State Adopt-A-Highway Program. Our stretch of road (identified by standard Adopt-A-Highway signs at the beginning and end) starts at the intersection of Longstreet Drive and Orange Plank Road (Rt 621) and goes for two miles toward the Orange County line.

<u>We</u> are responsible for organizing a cleanup at least four times a year. The VDOT supplies the bags, safety vests and notification signs for each cleanup effort. Mike Sullivan is our point of contact. The scheduled clean-up dates for this coming year are **April 9th, June 4th, September 3rd, and December 3rd**. We will meet at the Izaak Walton clubhouse at 0900 and convoy to our site.

Conservation is important - this is just one way to provide a needed service to our community and help maintain our beautiful roadways. This effort can be joined by other organizations as well – if you know of another group (such as the Boy Scouts...) that would like to schedule a service project we would be glad to accommodate.

- Fishing in the pond shall be confined to members and their immediate families, and up to 10 guests. All state laws shall be strictly adhered to.
